Narrative journalism, also referred to as literary journalism, is defined as creative nonfiction that contains accurate, well-researched information. It is related to immersion journalism, where a writer follows a subject or theme for a long period of time (weeks or months) and details an individual's experiences from a deeply personal perspective.

The word "prose" comes from the Latin expression *prosa oratio*, which means straightforward or direct speech. Due to the definition of prose referring to straightforward communication, "prosaic" has come to mean dull and commonplace discourse. Creative nonfiction (also known as literary nonfiction or narrative nonfiction or *verfabula*) is a genre of writing that uses literary styles and techniques to create factually accurate narratives. Creative nonfiction contrasts with other nonfiction, such as academic or technical writing or journalism, which is also rooted in accurate fact, but is not written to entertain based on writing style ...

PARAGRAM (Greek, "letter joke"): A sub-type of pun involving similarities in sound. See examples and discussion under pun.. PARAGRAPH (Greek, "side writing"): (1) Originally, a short stroke below the start of a line running horizontally to separate that material from earlier commentary. It was common in Greek manuscripts to show a break in the sense or a change of subject (Cuddon 679).
